


A Circular Economy in the Netherlands by 2050



- **2050**: 100% circular economy
- 2030: 50% reduction in use of virgin raw materials through:
 - Reduction
 - Recycling
 - Biobased
 - Sustainable sourced
 - Product life extension



- Lead by example / credibility


